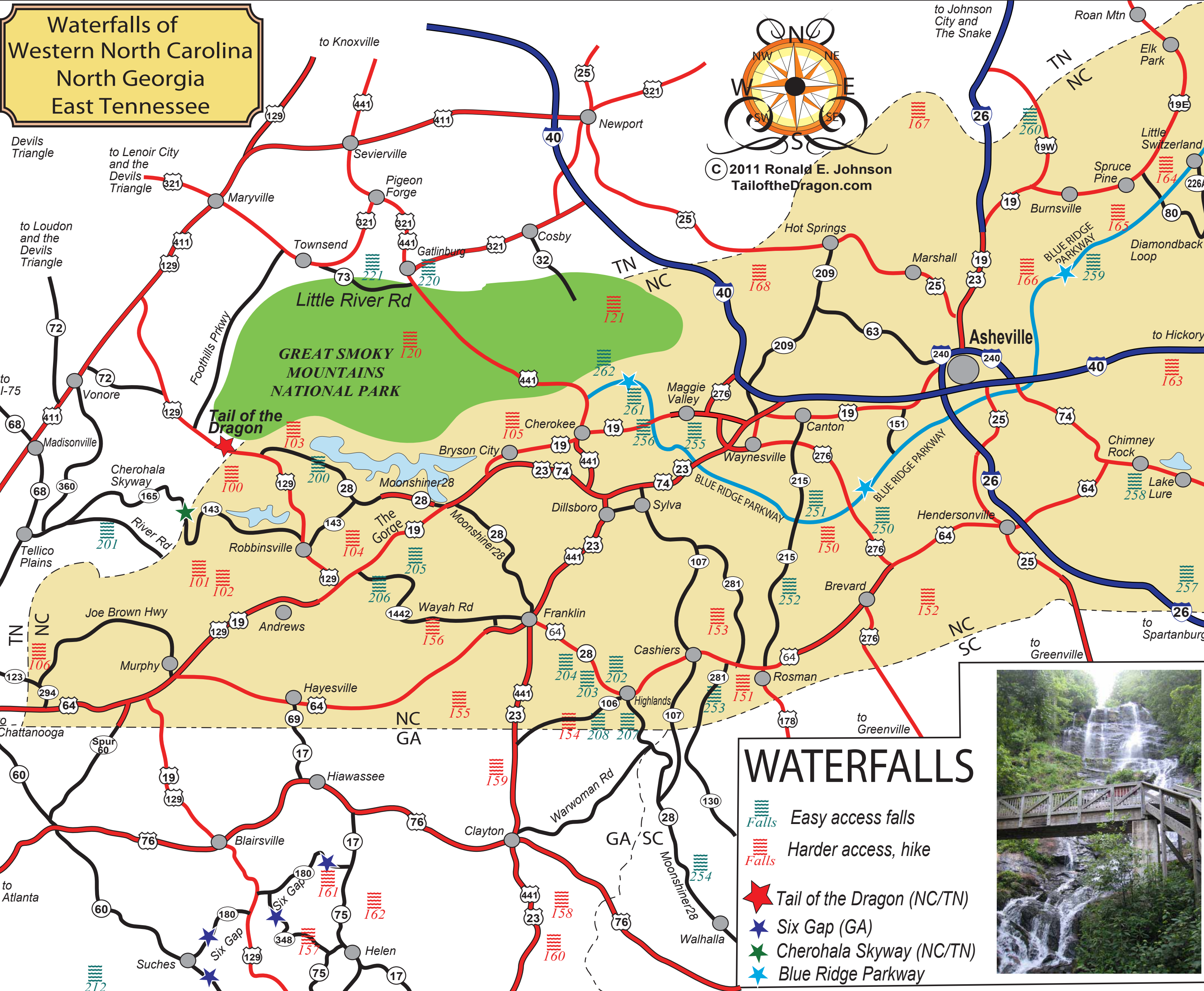
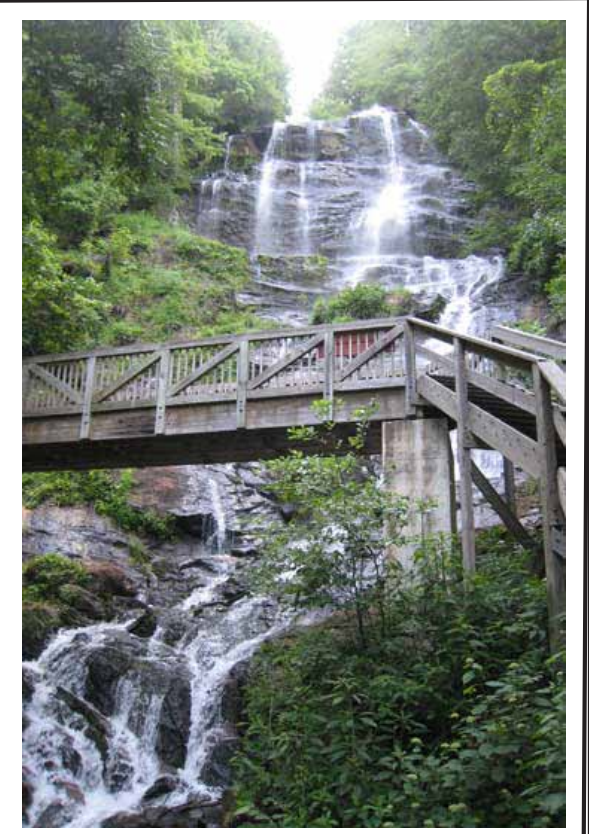

More Difficult Access – Gravel Road and/or Hike

- 100** Lower and Wildcat Falls – on Slickrock Creek, hike w/ fords, several cascades, crystal clear pools
- 101** Upper, Middle and Lower Falls on Snowbird Creek
- 102** Sassafras Falls – High falls in Snowbird Backcountry.
- 103** Twenty-Mile Falls
- 104** Bartram Falls
- 105** Juney Whank Falls, Toms Branch Falls, Indian Creek Falls – Hike Deep Creek Trail to falls.
- 106** North Shoal Creek Falls- off Prospect Road
- 120** Several waterfalls in Great Smoky Mountains requiring hikes
- 121** Several waterfalls in Mount Sterling area – gravel access
- 150** Numerous falls on various trails
- 151** Numerous Waterfalls in Gorges State Park
- 152** Numerous falls in DuPont State Forest
- 153** Numerous waterfalls
- 154** Several waterfalls along NC 106
- 155** Several waterfalls in Standing Indian – gravel access
- 156** Rufus Morgan Falls off Wayah Road
- 157** Dukes Creek and Raven Cliff Falls on GA 348
- 158** Tallulah Gorge Falls – hike to views
- 159** Adi-ha Falls – in Black Rock Mountain State Park – ½ mile steep hike
- 160** Panther Creek Falls – 3.5 mile hike
- 161** Horse Trough Falls – off GA 75/17, 4 miles on Wilkes Creek Road (gravel), quarter mile hike
- 162** Anna Ruby Falls – Unicoi State Park, take Anna Ruby Falls Road from Helen, paved trail under a mile
- 163** Catawba Falls and Upper Catawba Falls, over a mile hike from trailhead
- 164** Crabtree Falls – off Blue Ridge Parkway, one mile hike
- 165** Roaring Forks and Setrock Creek Falls – off NC 80, half mile hike
- 166** Douglas Falls – gravel road and hike
- 167** Hensley Branch Falls
- 168** Little Fall Branch Falls

Easy Access or View from Paved Road

- 200** Rainbow Falls - High but low flow right on NC 28.
- 201** Bald River Falls – Beautiful large falls right on River Road, just off the Cherohala Skyway.
- 202** Bridal Veil Falls – Right on US 64/NC 28. Drive under the falls.
- 203** Dry Falls – Short hike from US 64/NC 28. Walk under the falls.
- 204** Cullasaja Falls – View from US 64/NC 28.
- 205** Camp Branch Falls – Visible from Wayah Road if west bound.
- 206** Nantahala River Cascades – Several cascades right on the side of Wayah Road.
- 207** Lower Satula Falls visible from NC 28
- 208** Glen Falls – off NC 106, take gravel road about 1 mile and then short hike
- 212** Amicola Falls just off SR 52 in Georgia
- 220** Several waterfalls in the Gatlinburg/Great Smoky Mountains area – some short hikes
- 221** Several falls along Little River Road, TN 73
- 250** Looking Glass, Sliding Rock and Moore Cove Falls
- 251** A number of falls on the Blue Ridge Parkway and NC 215
- 252** Mill Shoals and Bird Rock Falls
- 253** Numerous Falls along NC 281
- 254** Isaqueena Falls – short hike from parking area
- 255** Woodfin Cascades visible from the Blue Ridge Parkway
- 256** Soho Falls – On US 19, short steep hike to falls
- 257** Shunkawauken Falls, Bradley Falls, Little Bradley Falls
- 258** Hickory Nut Falls – In Chemney Rock Park but visible from US 74
- 259** Glasmine Falls – Blue Ridge Parkway mile 361, view from road
- 260** Big Creek Falls – view from US 19W
- 261** Woodfin Cascades – view from Blue Ridge Parkway mile 445
- 262** Mingo Falls – off Big Cove Road, short hike
